Managing Visibility, Time, and Space has proven effective in reducing traffic fatalities and collisions as employed worldwide by the United States Navy, Air Force, and Marine Corps. Many organizations such as insurance underwriters, police, public utilities, and delivery fleets require completion of the course by their drivers.

This program can enhance driver safety, convenience, and comfort using the most up to date research in the field. It provides practical guidance for preventing traffic collisions through instruction on visual scanning techniques, critical driving information, and procedures for handling vehicular and traffic emergencies.

Personal involvement in class discussion is encouraged through the use of scenes depicting traffic situations. Each topic has concepts for class discussion.

Topics covered in *Managing Visibility, Time, and Space* include:

- Adjusting Speed
- Margin of Safety
- Your Vehicle
- Driving Emergencies
- You the Driver

Instructors are re-certified every three years to ensure they have the most up to date information. Currently, approximately 2000 DIP instructors world-wide.
