



NCKTC Departmental Scholarship Information for 2010-11

- Applicant may be a traditional or non-traditional student.
- Twenty-five (25) NCKTC Departmental Scholarships (One scholarship will be awarded for each first-year program). Each scholarship will be worth \$500 and will be disbursed \$250 per semester. Scholarship is renewable for a second year if the awarded student is on an Associate of Applied Science degree track and maintains scholarship eligibility each semester.
- Prospective students are encouraged to apply regardless of prior academic performance or financial status.
- Applicants are encouraged to file for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and must meet federal aid eligibility requirements whether they file for aid or not.
- To be eligible for scholarship consideration, please complete the following steps:
 - 1) Submit scholarship application.
 - 2) Submit one page essay explaining educational and career goals
 - 3) Submit reference letter
 - 4) Submit Copy of current high school transcript or GED.
 - 5) Submit Copy of transcript from other post secondary institutions attended.
 - 6) Submit copy of college entrance test scores (ACT, ASSET or COMPASS scores).

Only scholarship applications accompanied by ALL supportive documentation will be considered for award. This includes if you have already submitted this information to another NCKTC department or office. All the above items 1-6 should be mailed at the same time contained in the same envelope.

- Students do not need to have an Application for Admission on file with NCKTC to submit a scholarship application.
- Deadline to submit scholarship application for Fall 2010 programs is May 7, 2010.
- Fall 2010 scholarship recipients will be notified by mail no later than June 15, 2010.
